Mrs. Lizzie Belle Wenke

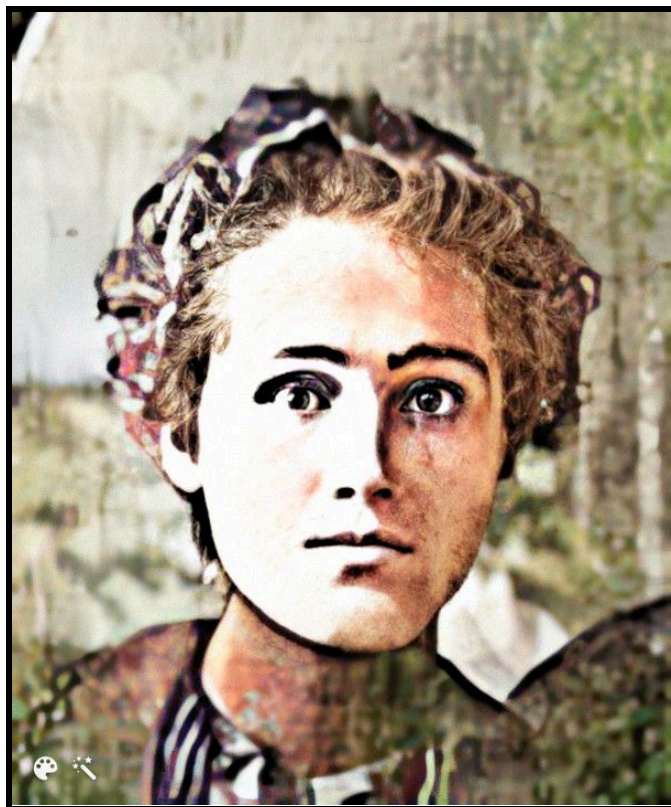

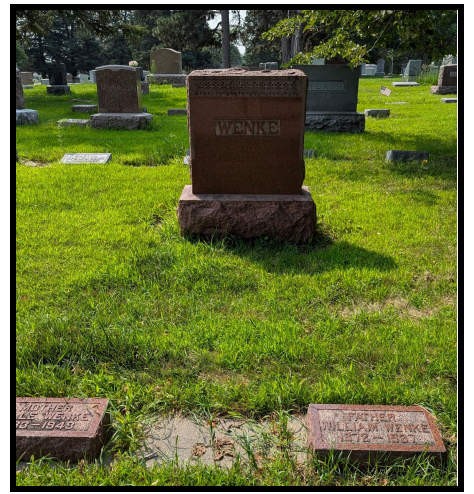
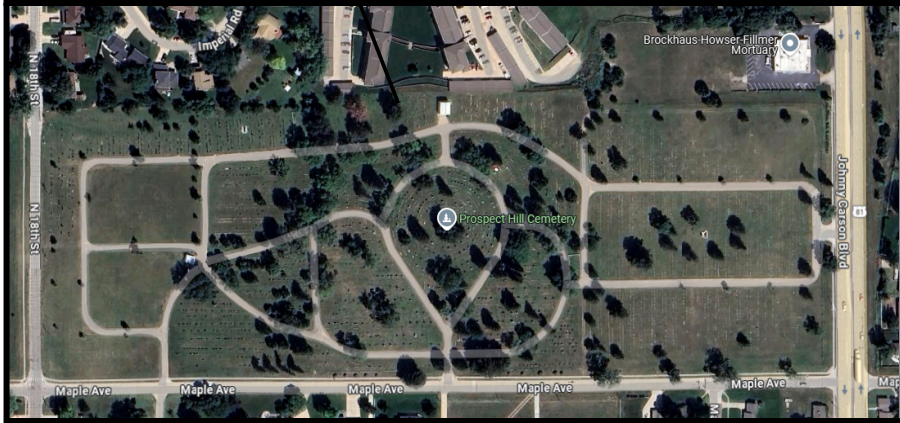
